

We advise


- Peer-to-peer strategy consulting for universities and departments

HFD CHANGE

- » 9-week collegial consultation in small teams
 - Participants from teaching and support facilities consult with each other in small teams on concrete challenges in their work and jointly develop ideas for solutions
 - Methodical introduction and exchange of experiences with all participants in 3 online meetings
 - 5 self-organized consulting sessions in the team



- » Online platform for HE teachers to have digital teaching activities certificated and documented
- » For teachers who want to:
 - integrate up-to-date teaching methods in their courses
 - use innovative learning scenarios
 - engage with effective university teaching even outside formal continued education structures

- » European initiative: part of the Digital Education Action Plan (2021-2027)
- » Community of Practice
- » European Commission project, implemented by a consortium:
 - DAAD
 - Stifterverband
 - Other partners: EDEN (Estonia/European), EADTU
 (Netherlands/European), HPI-School (Germany), UEFISCDI (Romania),
 Educraftor (Finland)



Activities in the Hub

- » Community of Practice
 - Online environment
 - Squads: working groups on different themes
 - Workshop (face-to-face)
 - Articles, publications, etc.
 - Mentoring programmes
 - "Acceleration programmes"



- » Very soon: start of the testing of the online environment
- » June 2022: online CoP up and running
- » June 2022: first workshop (Tallinn)
- » September 2022: big public event (Brussels)
- » (...)
- » February 2025: end of the Hub (?)
